Applicants must be 16-18 and must present the following:

- High school transcripts
- TOEFL score 80 (internet-based), 213 (computer-based); IELTS 6.0; CAE B2 with a minimum score of 169; PTE 57; EU Business School; English placement test; native speaker of English or equivalent.
